



B.C.F.P. Cowichan Logging Division Caycuse Camp Fonds

Biographical Information

The Cowichan Division of BC Forest Products Ltd. (BCFP) was created in 1946 by consolidating several logging operations in the Cowichan Lake area, including Industrial Timber Mills Ltd. The Division was initially headquartered at Youbou but later moved to Caycuse, an isolated logging camp that had been established in 1926 on the south shore of Cowichan Lake. BCFP built a new town to replace the old floathouses and bunkhouses, including an elementary school, store and community hall. At its peak in the early 1950s, an estimated 1000 loggers and their families lived at the camp. The later Division included the Renfrew area and a logging camp at Nitinat.

Until the introduction of truck logging in 1954, all of the logs from the region were transported by rail and boomed across Cowichan Lake to be used in the sawmill owned by BCFP at Youbou. From 1957 timber was also used at the newsprint plant in Crofton. In 1962 the Cowichan Logging Division held the rights to 83,000 acres of timber and employed 200 men, half of whom lived in the Caycuse camp with their families. Fletcher Challenge Canada acquired the operation in 1988 and closed the camp at Caycuse in 1992. Operations were transferred to the Honeymoon Bay Operations, located at the old Western Forest Industries Gordon River Logging Camp.

Custodial History

The records were salvaged by the Kaatza Museum from the Fletcher Challenge Canada office at Caycuse in 1992 and donated to the Kaatza Archives.

Scope and Content

The fonds consists primarily of office files from the Cowichan Logging Division of BC Forest Products Ltd., with the vast majority of records created between 1946-1968. These include the records of divisional managers related to management issues such as accidents, union, legal affairs and finances, and also includes correspondence with BCFP's Head Office in Vancouver.

Also in the Fonds are the records of the Caycuse logging camp's personnel department and records produced in the administration of the camp itself. The fonds also includes a series of maps and plans documenting camps, construction plans, logging activity, railway and road surveys and forest cover.

Notes:

Physical Condition: Both files and maps are mainly in good condition. Some files are bent due to incorrect storage, and some maps are exhibiting water damage. The maps were rolled up upon arrival and remain rolled, meaning they will be bent until remediation can occur.

Arrangement: When the records first arrived at the Kaatza Station Museum and Archives, archivists placed all files in chronological order, meaning original order was lost. This remains the physical order of the records, however the current archivist has attempted to recreate the original order in the intellectual arrangement contained in this finding aid. The series contained below are based on the various people and departments records were produced and held by.

Series 1: BCFP Cowichan Logging Division Superintendent's Records

Date: 1942-1989.

Scope and Content: Contained in this series are the records of the management of BCFP's Cowichan Logging Division, in particular those of the divisional superintendent. H.E. Hobson was Superintendent for the Division from 1946-1964 and was succeeded by Les R. Way. The series also contains records belonging to Bill Dumont, Logging Manager for BCFP's Cowichan/Renfrew Division in the 1980s. The series contains records related to all functions of the division, and includes the superintendent's correspondence, as well as records related to logging, forestry, safety, personnel matters, camp administration, fire protection, land and tenure, booms and mills, and finances.

Note on Arrangement: The series is intellectually broken down into subseries according to the function of the records. This may or may not be an accurate representation of original order.
